SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS

1. Purpose. To publish the Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) Federal Holiday schedule, define the holiday observance period, define terminology regarding types of training days and holiday days pertaining to recruit training, and to establish associated training requirements.

2. Background. Per references (a) and (b) the Marine Corps Recruit Depot/Eastern Recruiting Region Parris Island (MCRD/ERR PI) will observe all Federal Holidays. Per reference (c), civilians will receive all federal holidays off. Reference (a) is the Marine Corps Order on leave and liberty. Reference (b) is the Depot Order on leave and liberty. Reference (c) is the Civilian Personnel Manual. Reference (d) is the Depot Recruit Training Order.

3. Action. In order to observe holidays and provide recruits support necessary to safely and efficiently train, the Depot has identified three types of training days that make up recruit training: full training days, partial training days, and holiday routine days.

a. Full Training Days. Full training days require total Depot support in all areas and occur as normal Monday through Friday operations.

b. Partial Training Days

(1) Partial training days require support in specific areas as identified in the recruit training schedules published by the Depot. As a guideline, these days do not require general Depot support, but rather limited support for such services as medical, dental, clothing appointments, exchange visits, uniform and equipment issue, rifle issue, travel appointments, motor transport, and haircuts. Several variations of the partial training day exist.

(2) Normal Saturday routine. Saturdays normally require medical support and variations of recruit in-processing support. Variations may include the need to conduct live fire for Table 1 or Table 2 courses of fire.

(3) Federal holiday designated as a partial training day. These holidays either fall, or are observed, on a Monday or Friday in which a three day liberty period is authorized. These days are treated very similarly to a Saturday requiring the same support considerations; however, civilians cannot be required to work.

(4) Partial training day during a weekday held in conjunction with a four-day liberty period. In situations where the Federal Holiday is granted a four day liberty period, the holiday itself will be designated a non-work/non-support day as defined under the holiday routine day while the remaining week day will be designated a partial training day. This type of partial training day may require such services as listed above, whether requiring Marine, Navy, or civilian personnel to execute. These services require only the personnel necessary to complete the service for the required amount of time. In some cases, this day may be considered a day off for civilians when directed by executive order. When designated a Federal Holiday by executive order, services provided to recruit training by government employees and contracted or non-appropriated funded agencies (Recruit Clothing and Marine Corps Community Services, South Carolina (MCCS, SC)) may still be scheduled if given prior coordination. Scheduling conflicts with MCCS, SC will be resolved by the Head, Retail and Services. In the absence of an executive order, civilians who are not needed to work these partial training days will be encouraged to take annual leave.

(5) Sunday is designated a partial training day. Some four day liberty periods, such as Thanksgiving, may create undesirable situations such as three day firing weeks or breaks in the recruit firing schedule and shortages for physical

training and other training requirements. To alleviate these problems, Sunday is designated a partial training day. Support requirements are similar to a normal Saturday; however, civilians will not normally be required to work.

(6) Every effort will be made during the scheduling of partial training days to minimize support requirements on all military and civilian personnel, especially those Federal Holidays designated as partial training days, and partial training days directly preceding/proceeding a Federal Holiday.

(7) After all support requirements have been met by supporting agencies in accordance with enclosure (1) and the recruit training schedule, those agencies are authorized a liberty policy for personnel not required.

c. Holiday Routine Days. Holiday routine days require no Depot support, except emergency services. Holiday routine will be observed in accordance with reference (d) on those holidays designated below and in enclosure (1).

(1) Per references (a), (b), and (c) the following Federal Holidays will be observed:

(2) Enclosure (1) provides an in-depth breakdown of the observance period for each Federal Holiday, including the start and end times for the holiday liberty period, and the required training for each observance period based on the types of days designated. Enclosure (1) is intended to guide schedulers in the construction of recruit training schedules while providing commanders and officers-in-charge (OICs) with basic planning guidance. The enclosure is not intended to provide a list of all support requirements. In all cases, the recruit training schedule must be utilized to fully capture all support requirements.

(3) Enclosure (2) is the FY20 MPP. For recruit training companies that started training during FY19, but will graduate during FY20, the FY20 MPP applies for scheduling and planning purposes.


4. Applicability

(1) Provide all support necessary for the safe and efficient execution of the recruit training schedule.

(2) Ensure all support requirements for partial training days have been met, per the enclosures and the recruit training schedule, prior to commencing liberty for any period.

5. Full Training Day for WFTBn and the RTR Training Companies on Rifle Range Firing Week (KD/Table 1), Table 2/BWT, and Land Nav 2. **Appropriate medical coverage/support required.**
6. Depot PAO and WFTBn are directed to ensure proper coordination is conducted with local community agencies and media to ensure public awareness (especially boaters) that live fire will be conducted on the PISC Rifle Range on 24 Nov 19; 21-22 and 28-29 Dec 19.
7. Partial Training Day for RTR Training Companies only. Appropriate Medical coverage/support required.

8. This holiday is designated as "Washington's Birthday" in section 6103(a) of title 5 of the United States Code, which is the law that specifies holidays for Federal employees. Though other institutions such as state and local governments and private businesses may use other names, it is OPM policy to always refer to holidays by the names designated in the law.

9. Branch Medical Clinic support will be unavailable; there will be no sick call or medical coverage for training events. Urgent but non-Emergent medical care will be referred to the Beaufort Naval Hospital Extended Care Clinic. Medical coverage's will resume the following training day. Medical Support for events will be finalized during holiday coordination meetings.
