Subj: BASE EXTERIOR ARCHITECTURAL PLAN (BEAP)

Ref: (a) Master Plan for Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris
Island, South Carolina of Sep 92 (NOTAL)

1. Purpose. To provide policy, prescribe procedures, and assign responsibilities for management of the Base Exterior Architectural Plan (BEAP) for the Marine Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD), Parris Island, per reference (a).

2. Cancellation. DepO 11010.1.

3. Background. MCRD Parris Island's Master Plan, as directed by reference (b), included and established the first BEAP. Parris Island has the responsibility to ensure that all new construction, additions, alterations, or repairs to all structures, roads, and grounds, adhere to the approved BEAP to effect a cohesive program. The BEAP will serve as the guideline for unifying and improving the Depot's visual qualities. The BEAP establishes visual assets and liabilities which contribute to the overall visual image of Parris Island. The Depot's developed base design themes are enhanced throughout the Depot by the design guidelines for architecture, landscape, lighting, signage, and site furniture as established in the BEAP.

a. Parris Island has experienced significant growth ranging from the era of the 1890s Navy Shipyard to the present, especially during war/conflict episodes involving U.S. Marines. All of the development during these eras was accomplished without benefit of a BEAP. This plan will guide current and future project designs and unify the visual themes of the MCRD Parris Island.

b. This Order formally establishes a program to implement and manage the BEAP for all visual exterior resources of MCRD Parris Island.

4. Definitions

Architecture All elements of a building's envelope including roofing, cladding, paint, doors, and windows.

Landscape All site features such as planters, sidewalks, round cover, trees, and shrubs.

Lighting Exterior building lighting, site lighting, and lighting of roads and grounds.

Signage All exterior signs including building signs, informational signs, directional signs, and identification signs.

Site

Furniture All exterior site furniture such as benches, mailboxes, and trash receptacles.

5. Action

a. All organizational Commanders and Special and General Staff shall, on a continuing basis, integrate the BEAP with any operations and plans involving visual exterior resources as early as possible before making a final decision.

b. The Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4 (AC/S, G-4) is designated the activity point of contact to establish, direct, maintain, and coordinate the MCRD Parris Island BEAP. Normally, communications to/from the AC/S, G-4 will be via the Public Works Officer.

(1) Prior to any project being started that alters the visual exterior resources of Parris Island, the plans and scope of work must be forwarded to Public Works for comment/recommendations and action.

(2) Public Works will provide support to Commanders, Staff Officers and project managers for construction and maintenance projects.

(3) Public Works will develop recommendations for programmed projects coordinated with Parris Island's annual work plan to implement the BEAP and correct existing violations.

c. A BEAP Advisory Committee is established to provide advice and recommendations on procedures, planning, and management of all assets on the MCRD Parris Island to ensure compliance with reference (a). The BEAP is comprised of:

(1) Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4, Chairman

(2) Public Works Officer

(3) Engineering Director, Public Works

(4) BEAP Coordinator, Public Works

(5) Facilities Maintenance Officer

d. The Committee will meet as required on call of the Chairman.

6. Applicability. This policy and guidance applies to all Department of Defense agencies, military organizations and other authorized activities located on the MCRD Parris Island and for all land and structures under the management of MCRD Parris Island.
