Subj: STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR THE PARRIS ISLAND OUTDOOR POOL

1. Situation. To establish a standard operating procedure for the Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island (MCRD) outdoor pool for recreational use.

2. Cancellation. DepO 5101.6F

3. Mission

a. This Order publishes policy and procedures for recreational use of the outdoor pool on MCRD. The pool is managed by Marine Corps Community Services South Carolina (MCCS). All maintenance and facility concerns are managed by the AC/S G-4.

b. This Order has been completely revised and should be reviewed in its entirety.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations.

(1) Commander's Intent. To provide a recreational pool for fee based use by all eligible patrons, while providing a safe and family friendly environment. Fees will be posted on web-site and at pool.

(2) Concept of Operations. The management of the outdoor recreational pool will be conducted by MCCS in accordance with the references listed above.

5. Administration and Logistics

a. All ranks, officer and enlisted, their dependents and all patrons with a valid ID are eligible to use the outdoor pool. Guests must be accompanied by an authorized sponsor.

b. Children under ten (10) years of age must be accompanied by a parent or responsible individual sixteen (16) years of age or older with a valid ID.

c. Hours of operation. The outdoor pool operates during the summer season, normally June through August. Information concerning specific hours of operation, pre-season and post-season swimming programs will be posted at a separate time.

d. Rules and Regulations. All rules and regulations will be posted at the pool. The rules are subject to the interpretation and enforcement by the aquatic staff on duty.

e. Sanitation. The Medical Department is responsible for weekly inspection and testing of water in the pool and will report to MCCS any conditions that may have adverse effects on the health of pool users. General sanitary measures to be observed by patrons are as follows:

(1) All persons will take a shower prior to using the pool.

(2) Children wearing diapers will not be permitted in the pool unless they are wearing swim diapers.

(3) Smoking is not permitted within the pool area.

(4) Glass containers are not permitted on Pool Deck.

f. Severe Weather

(1) The MCAS Beaufort weather officer and/or Cherry Point weather officer is responsible for originating and terminating thunderstorm, tornado, wind, and/or rain conditions for this command.

(2) The decision to close the pool in the event of severe weather is made by the Aquatics Director. If the Aquatic Director is not in the area, the Assistant Aquatics Director or senior guard will make the decision, with the concurrence of the Health and Fitness Director.

g. Emergency Action Plan

(1) The emergency action plan covering such areas as injuries, chlorine leaks, and medical emergencies will be established by the Aquatics Director. All personnel will be instructed in these procedures as part of their training.


(2) The Parris Island Fire Department will provide ambulance service and treatment when requested by the aquatic staff on duty at the outdoor pool.

h. Pool Party Procedures. For a unit pool party contact your installation MCCS Coordinator at 228-7333.

6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to all personnel assigned to, working aboard or visiting MCRD.

b. Signal. The Order is effective on the date signed.

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE TO BE ENFORCED BY ALL POOL OFFICIALS:

GENERAL RULES:

1. NO RUNNING, PUSHING, OR HORSEPLAY.
2. NO SITTING OR STANDING ON SHOULDERS
3. NO FOUL LANGUAGE OR OBSCENE GESTURES WILL BE TOLERATED.
4. NO GLASS CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND ALLOWED IN POOL AREA.
5. ALL PATRONS MUST PRESENT VALID MILITARY I.D. WHEN CHECKING IN; ALL PATRONS MUST CHECK IN.
6. SHOWERS ARE ENCOURAGED BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL.
7. RADIOS ARE ALLOWED BY PATRONS, BUT MUST BE PLAYED SOFTLY. NO OBSCENE OR INAPPROPRIATE MUSIC WILL BE ALLOWED.
8. NO HANGING ON OR AROUND LADDERS AND ROPES.
9. NO SITTING ON GUTTERS.
10. NO LOITERING IN RESTROOMS.
11. ONLY PROPER SWIM SUITS ALLOWED. NO CUT-OFFS. SWIM SUITS REQUIRED. THONGS ARE NOT PERMITTED. DO-RAGS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL.
12. NECKLACES AND DANGLING EARRINGS ARE FORBIDDEN IN POOLS (LIFEGUARDS INCLUDED).
13. WATER SHOES ARE ACCEPTABLE.
14. ONLY WATER PROOF DIAPERS ARE PERMITTED IN POOL.
15. T-SHIRTS AND GYM SHORTS ARE PERMITTED, BUT MUST BE WORN OVER SWIM SUIT.
16. NO REVEALING BATHING SUITS (I.E. THONG BOTTOMS) ARE ALLOWED.
17. POOL PERSONNEL ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR PERSONAL ITEMS.
18. TELEPHONE IS FOR EMERGENCY AND LIFEGUARD USE ONLY. (CHILDREN ARE ALSO ALLOWED TO CALL PARENTS FOR A RIDE.)
19. NO GLASS MASK OR SCUBA GEAR ALLOWED IN POOLS (UNLESS AUTHORIZED).
20. ONLY LIFEGUARDS ARE PERMITTED ON LIFEGUARD STANDS.
21. NO TOUCHING OR PLAYING WITH ANY LIFEGUARD EQUIPMENT.
22. ONLY PATRONS 18 YEARS OR OLDER ARE ALLOWED TO REMAIN IN THE POOL DURING POOL BREAKS.
23. NO PERSONS WITH OPEN SORES, CONTAGIOUS SKIN DISEASE OR INFECTIONS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE POOL.

24. ONLY ONE PERSON ALLOWED ON THE SLIDE AT A TIME.
25. NO CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 2 IS PERMITTED TO USE THE SLIDE.
26. ALL CHILDREN WHO ARE UNABLE TO TOUCH POOL BOTTOM, AND HAVE NOT PASSED SWIM TEST, MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT OR GUARDIAN AT THE BOTTOM OF THE SLIDE.
27. EVERYONE MUST EXIT SLIDE FEET FIRST.
28. AGE LIMIT FOR UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN IS TEN YEARS OLD. CHILD MUST ALSO PRESENT A VALID I.D.
29. ANY CHILDREN UNDER TEN YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
30. APPROPRIATE SWIM TOYS ONLY. HARD DIVING STICKS, RAFTS, AND OTHER LARGE FLOTATION DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED.
31. APPROPRIATE FLOTATION DEVICES INCLUDE WATER-WINGS AND RINGS WITH SEATS.
32. PARENTS MUST BE IN POOL AND WITHIN ARM'S REACH OF ANY CHILD USING A FLOTATION DEVICE. THIS INCLUDES SWIM SUITS WITH BUILT-IN FLOTATION DEVICE.
33. LIFEJACKETS AND FLOTATION DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON SLIDE. THIS INCLUDES SWIM SUITS WITH BUILT-IN FLOTATION DEVICE.
34. THE BABY POOL IS DESIGNED FOR SMALL NON-SWIMMING CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF SIX ONLY. AN ADULT OR GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT WITH THEIR CHILD AT ALL TIMES.
35. NO PETS ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR WITHIN THE POOL COMPOUND.
(EXCEPTION: SEEING EYE DOG)
36. PUBLIC DISPLAY OF AFFECTION IS NOT ALLOWED. THIS WILL BE LEFT UP TO DISCRETION OF LIFEGUARD.

DIVING RULES:

1. NO SWIMMING IN FRONT OF THE DIVING BOARDS WHILE IN USE.
2. ONLY ONE PERSON ALLOWED ON DIVING BOARD AT A TIME.
3. DIVING PERMITTED FROM THE SIDE OF POOL ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS.
4. ONLY WRIST BAND SWIMMERS AND THOSE OVER THE AGE OF 14 ARE ALLOWED IN THE DEEP AND DIVING AREAS.
5. NO INWARD DIVES/FLIPS OR BACK FLIPS ARE PERMITTED FROM THE DIVING BOARD OR SIDE OF POOL. MCCS SC LIFEGUARDS HAVE THE RIGHT NOT TO ALLOW ANY PATRON TO JUMP IF THEY FEAR FOR THE SAFETY OF THE PATRON.

6. ALL DIVERS WILL BOUNCE ONLY ONCE PRIOR TO THEIR DIVE OR JUMP FROM THE BOARDS.
7. NON-SWIMMERS WILL NOT USE THE DIVING BOARDS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SWIM LESSONS AS ACCOMPANIED BY AN INSTRUCTOR.

EATING RULES:

1. FOOD/DRINKS (OTHER THAN WATER) PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.
2. NO GUM ALLOWED IN OR AROUND POOL.
3. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED (UNLESS AUTHORIZATION IS RECEIVED).
4. ALL MCCS SC POOL FACILITIES ARE SMOKE FREE ENVIRONMENTS.

SWIM TEST RULES:

1. SWIM TESTS FOR CHILDREN 14 YEARS AND YOUNGER INCLUDES: SWIMMING TWO LENGTHS IN THE DEEP END AND TREADING WATER FOR ONE MINUTE. THE FRONT CRAWL OR BREAST STROKE MUST BE USED AND MUST BE SKILLFUL ENOUGH FOR STAFF APPROVAL.
2. WHEN USING FRONT CRAWL, ARMS MUST COME COMPLETELY OUT OF THE WATER.
3. SWIMMING BELOW SURFACE IS NOT PERMITTED.
4. NO DOGGY-PADDLING PERMITTED.
5. THE WRIST BAND MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY THE CHILD IN ORDER TO SWIM IN THE DEEP END.
6. THE WRIST BAND GIVES THE CHILD ACCESS TO SWIM IN THE DEEP END OF THE POOLS.
7. IF A PATRON IS OVER THE AGE OF 14 AND THEIR SWIMMING ABILITY IS QUESTIONABLE, THE MCCS SC LIFEGUARDS HAVE THE RIGHT TO REQUEST A SWIM TEST OR HAVE THE PATRON MOVE TO AN AREA OF THE POOL WHERE HE/SHE CAN TOUCH.

THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO THE INTERPRETATION AND ENFORCEMENT BY THE LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. ANY PERSON WARNED TWICE WILL BE ASKED TO SPEND A PERIOD OUT OF THE POOL. NEXT OFFENSE IS SUBJECT TO EXPULSION FROM THE FACILITY.

STORM OR DESTRUCTIVE WEATHER STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

THE CLOSING OF THE POOL IN THE EVENT THAT THE AQUATIC DIRECTOR IS NOT IN THE AREA IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ASSISTANT AQUATICS DIRECTOR OR HEAD GUARD, WITH CONCURRENCE OF THE AQUATICS DIRECTOR OR HEALTH AND FITNESS DIRECTOR.

THE CHERRY POINT WEATHER OFFICER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ORIGINATING AND TERMINATING THUNDERSTORM, TORNADO, WIND, AND/OR RAIN CONDITIONS FOR THIS COMMAND. PHONE NUMBER: 252-466-3999

DEFINITIONS:

THUNDERSTROM, TORNADO, AND/OR WIND CONDITION #1

EMINENT STORM IS EXPECTED TO PASS OR FORM WITHIN FIVE NAUTICAL MILES OF MCAS IN LESS THAN ONE HOUR. PHENOMENA VISUALLY OBSERVED OR INDICATED ON WEATHER RADAR INSIDE A RADIUS OF FIFTEEN NAUTICAL MILES OF THE AIRFIELD THAT IS EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE SAFETY OF AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS AT MCAS BEAUFORT, OR WHEN MCAS BEAUFORT IS WITHIN A NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE SEVERE WEATHER WARNING.

THUNDERSTORM, TORNADO, AND/OR WIND CONDITIONS #2

DESTRUCTIVE WEATHER OF THE TYPE INDICATED ABOVE, THAT IS VISUALLY OBSERVED OR IS INDICATED ON WEATHER RADAR WITHIN A RADIUS OF THIRTY NAUTICAL MILES. A STORM IS PREDICTED TO FORM WITHIN THREE HOURS FROM THE TIME OF ISSUE OF ADVISORY BY MCAS BEAUFORT OR MCAS BEAUFORT IS WITHIN NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE SEVERE WEATHER WARNING AREA.

OTHER CONDITIONS:

THE POOL WILL BE CLEARED UPON THE SOUNDING OF THE PARRIS ISLAND LIGHTNING WITHIN FIVE (5) NAUTICAL MILES ALARM, OR ANY VISUAL SIGHTING OF LIGHTNING. THE POOL WILL REOPEN UPON THE SOUNDING OF THE PARRIS ISLAND ALL CLEAR ALARM OR ALL CLEAR FROM MCAS WEATHER.

THE POOL WILL BE CLEARED AT ANY TIME THAT VISIBILITY BECOMES UNSAFE.

The host agrees to and is responsible for any and all damages incurred during date of reservation.

The area will be cleaned before securing to include all trashcans emptied.

The host must supply PMO with a guest list of all non-military at least 72 hours prior to the event.
