#### What is Considered Oil?

EPA 40 CFR 112 SPCC Rule States:

Oil means oil of any kind in any form, including but not limited to: fats, oils, or greases of animal, fish, or marine mammal origin; **vegetable oils**, including oils from seeds, nuts, fruits, or kernels; and other oils and greases including **petroleum**, **fuel oil**, **sludge**, **synthetic oils**, **mineral oils**, **oil refuse**, **or oil mixed with other wastes**.

#### What is Reportable?

- Leaks
- Drip Marks
- Discoloration
- Pools of Leaked or Spilled Oil
- Stressed Vegetation
