UNIVERSAL WASTE PROGRAM

Regulated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), **Universal Waste** is a category of waste materials designated as "hazardous waste" but contain materials that are very common. Items like Batteries, Pesticides, Mercury-Containing Equipment, Lamps, and more are collected and recycled to reduce the quantity of these wastes going to municipal solid waste landfills or combustors.
