UNIVERSAL WASTE PROGRAM

Regulated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), **Universal Waste** is a category of waste materials designated as “hazardous waste” but contain materials that are very common. Items like Batteries, Pesticides, Mercury-Containing Equipment, Lamps, and more are collected and recycled to reduce the quantity of these wastes going to municipal solid waste landfills or combustors.

Aerosol can frequently contain flammable propellants such as propane or butane which can cause the aerosol can to demonstrate the hazardous characteristic for ignitability and may also be a hazardous waste for other reasons when discarded.
