UNIVERSAL WASTE PROGRAM

Regulated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), **Universal Waste** is a category of waste materials designated as “hazardous waste”, but containing materials that are very common. Items like Batteries, Pesticides, Mercury-Containing Equipment, Lamps, and more are collected and recycled in order to reduce the quantity of these wastes going to municipal solid waste landfills.

Aerosol Cans Are A Universal Waste!

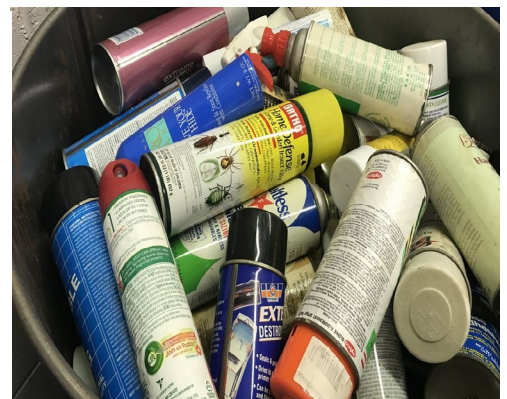
Aerosol cans frequently contain flammable propellants such as propane or butane which can cause the aerosol can to demonstrate the hazardous characteristic for ignitability. If discarded in the trash, contents could leak into the soil and groundwater.

Types of Aerosol Cans Include:

Spray Paint **WD-40** **Surface Cleaners** **Air Freshener**
Bug Spray **Air Duster** **Shaving Cream** **Disinfectant Spray**

How Do I Dispose of Aerosol Cans on Parris Island?

- Ensure Can is Empty
- Place Cap on Can to Eliminate Any Hazards
- Place Can in Recycle Receptacle Located at Your Facility
