## 3RD BN POND CATCH-AND-RELEASE FISHING

Subsistence fishing on **3rd Battalion Pond** has been prohibited in order to protect human health related to potential fish contamination resulting from a nearby Environmental Restoration Site. Through collaboration with the Navy, the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, and the Environmental Protection Agency, it has been determined that **CATCH AND RELEASE** fishing is still protective of human health while allowing people to enjoy the recreational benefits of fishing.
