### Spill Prevention



Did you know Parris Island has a **Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan**? The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) created the SPCC regulation to prevent oil from reaching navigable waters and adjoining shorelines, and to contain discharges of oil. When oil is spilled, it can endanger public health and the environment, as well as cost millions of dollars in cleanup and disposal.

#### What is Considered Oil?

EPA 40 CFR 112 SPCC Rule States:

**Oil means oil** of any kind in any form, including but not limited to: fats, oils, or greases of animal, fish, or marine mammal origin; **vegetable oils**, including oils from seeds, nuts, fruits, or kernels; and other oils and greases including **petroleum, fuel oil, sludge, synthetic oils, mineral oils, oil refuse, or oil mixed with other wastes.**

#### What is Reportable?

- Leaks
- Drip Marks
- Discoloration
- Pools of Leaked or Spilled Oil
- Stressed Vegetation
