

While we continue to maintain cautious health controls against the challenges presented by COVID-19, we are taking deliberate and incremental steps to allow greater weekend access for retirees and appropriately credentialed veterans. We ask that you read our new policy carefully.

Effective Sunday, October 18th, The Depot will allow access for retirees and appropriately credentialed veterans on Sundays each week to access the Commissary, Marine Corps Exchange, Legends Golf Course, Traditions, boat ramps and other activities. The Depot will remain closed to the public on Fridays and Saturdays. Please ensure that you wear a mask indoors, exercise heightened hand hygiene, and practice social distancing to ensure the safety of yourself and those aboard the Depot.

PLEASE NOTE: The Marine Corps Exchange will be restricted to active duty personnel IN UNIFORM ONLY from the hours of 1:00 PM to 3:30 PM on Sunday, to facilitate base liberty for our new Marines. This restriction includes families that live or work aboard the Depot and will be strictly enforced to protect the health of the new Marines prior to their departure to the School of Infantry. Contact between Depot visitors and new Marines remains prohibited, and individuals found in violation risk debarment from the installation.

On Fridays, the Depot will remain closed to anyone who does not live or have official business aboard the Depot, to allow our new Marines a day of on-base liberty. We appreciate your understanding, and look forward to welcoming you back aboard the Depot this Sunday, the 18th of October.
